COMMITTEE REPORTS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND MOTIONS

Note: Per Committee Chairs, copies of the Committee meeting minutes were available for attendees. All **February/March** Committee meeting minutes are posted on the ACERA website (www.acera.org) after approval at the **March 15, 2018**, Board meeting. This month's Committee reports were presented in the following order:

Investment:

George Wood gave an oral report stating that the Investment Committee met on March 14, 2018 at approximately 9:33 a.m. p.m. wherein a representative from Clarion Partners provided updated information on its organization, strategy, philosophy, processes, performance review and objectives, and the value proposition of the Industrial sector of the real estate market. After discussion, the Committee recommended that ACERA make an additional \$20 million investment in Clarion Lion Industrial Fund (LIT) Fund as part of ACERA's Real Estate Portfolio – Core.

It was moved by George Wood and seconded by Annette Cain-Darnes that the Board make an additional investment of \$20 million in Clarion Partners' Lion Industrial Trust Fund, pending completion of legal and investment due diligence and successful contract negotiation. The motion carried 8 yes (*Amaral, Basgal, Cain-Darnes, Gamble, Koppenhaver, Levy, Walker, Wood*), 0 no, and 0 abstentions.

Trustee Wood reported that a representative from Heitman Real Estate presented information regarding its organization's history, background, and culture of the firm, as well as the ongoing opportunity set, investment team and strategy of the Heitman Value Partners IV, L.P. Fund (HVP IV) and recommended that ACERA make an additional investment of \$20.0 million in HVP IV, bringing ACERA's total commitment in HVP IV to \$30 million – Value Added.

It was moved by George Wood and seconded by Liz Koppenhaver that the Board make an additional investment of \$20 million in HVP IV, bringing ACERA's total commitment in HVP IV to \$30 million, pending completion of legal and investment due diligence and successful contract negotiation. The motion carried 8 yes (Amaral, Basgal, Cain-Darnes, Gamble, Koppenhaver, Levy, Walker, Wood), 0 no, and 0 abstentions.

Trustee Wood further reported that in accordance with investment due diligence procedures and ACERA's *Private Equity Investment Policy*, Verus and Staff recommended to the Committee a total combined investment of up to a \$10 million commitment in Khosla Ventures VI, L.P. (KV VI) and KV Seed D, L.P. (KV Seed D), as part of the Venture Capital allocation in ACERA's Private Equities portfolio – Venture Capital.

It was moved by George Wood and seconded by Ophelia Basgal that the Board make a combined total investment of up to \$10 million in Khosla Ventures VI, L.P. and Khosla Ventures Seed D, L.P. as part of ACERA's Private Equities Portfolio, pending completion of legal and investment due diligence, background investigations, and successful contract negotiation. The motion carried 8 yes (Amaral, Basgal, Cain-Darnes, Gamble, Koppenhaver, Levy, Walker, Wood), 0 no, and 0 abstentions.

Trustee Wood further reported that the Committee discussed the following Information items: 1) State Street Bank's (SSB) custodial services and contract term expiration date of August 2018; 2) ACERA's 2017 Fourth Quarter performance for its Equities and Fixed Income Portfolio – ACERA's Total Fund returned 4.3% gross (4.3% net of fees); 3) ACERA's 2017 Fourth Quarter performance for its Real Estate Portfolio – ACERA's Total Fund returned 2.39% gross (2.15% net of fees); and 4) an oral update on the implementation of BlackRock's New Manager Structure for Domestic Equity – It was noted that ACERA Staff signed the IMA and Transition Management Agreement on February 14, 2018.

Chief Executive Officer Dave Nelsen informed the Board that ACERA Senior Investment Analyst Thomas Taylor and one of ACERA's Junior Investment Analyst (to be assigned), will be traveling to London for a private equity-buyout manager visit. Trustees provided its feedback to Staff regarding the proposed London-based trip.

NEW BUSINESS

Approval of Pay Item 219 – UAPD Extra Shift

ACERA Benefits Manager Sandra Dueñas-Cuevas gave an oral report regarding Pay Item 219 – UAPD Extra Shift \$30 PH. Ms. Dueñas-Cuevas stated that item number 7 of the *REQUEST FOR ACERA APPROVAL OF NEW PAY CODE* that was attached to her March 15, 2018 memo to the Board should be corrected to read as follows: "...**This pay is NOT an ad hoc payment**."

It was moved by Ophelia Basgal and seconded by George Wood to approve the inclusion of Pay Item 219 – UAPD Extra Shift \$30 PH as compensation earnable and pensionable compensation for members with entry dates before, on or after January 1, 2013, based on Government Code Sections 7522.34 and 31461. The motion carried 8 yes (*Amaral, Basgal, Cain-Darnes, Gamble, Koppenhaver, Levy, Walker, Wood*), 0 no, and 0 abstentions.

Total Operating Expense Budget Summary for January 2018

ACERA Fiscal Services Manager Margo Allen presented her March 15, 2018, memo regarding ACERA's total operating expenses for December 31, 2017, which reflected that ACERA is under budget by \$31,512. Ms. Allen reported that there was a \$25K overage in Staffing due to unforeseen Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA) in 2018. Ms. Allen stated that Fiscal Services Department Staff will make adjustments to the budget accordingly due to the overage in Staffing.

Chief Executive Officer's (CEO) Report

Mr. Nelsen presented his March 15, 2018, written Chief Executive Officer's Report, which provided an update on the following items: 1) Senior Manager Recruitment informing the Board that all vacancies have been filed; 2) Committee/Board Action Items; 3) Conference Schedule; and 4) Other.

Mr. Nelsen reported that the first session of the LEAN Six Sigma Project has been completed, which is a project to assist ACERA Staff to improve its performance by streamlining its processes for better efficiency. Assistant CEO Kathy Foster explained that ACERA's (Benefits) processes continue to be documented. Mr. Nelsen reported that the LEAN Project is going very well and stated that he would provide the Board with status updates.
