#### COMMITTEE REPORTS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND MOTIONS

Note: Per Committee Chairs, copies of the Committee meeting minutes were available for attendees. All **September/October** Committee meeting minutes are posted on the ACERA website (www.acera.org) after approval at the **October 21, 2016**, Board meeting. This month's Committee reports were presented in the following order:

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

New Business Item regarding Staff's recommendation to choose an External Audit Firm from the Request for Proposal (RFP) to audit FY 2016-2020.

Before voting, Trustees expressed their concerns regarding Brown's failure to disclose a lawsuit that was filed against it *after* responding to ACERA's RFP.

Trustees also expressed concern regarding the \$300,000.00 cost differential, the five-year term contract, and the issue of Brown's non-disclosure. After discussion, Staff was directed to begin negotiations with WACO to reach an agreement for a "floor" (lower fee) amount and possibly a shorter contract term. Ms. Allen reported that she intended on negotiating with WACO; however, she could not begin the negotiations until the Board had selected a Firm. Staff will monitor the contract and will provide an update at the next Audit Committee meeting.

#### 16-130

It was moved by Tarrell Gamble and seconded by Annette Cain-Darnes to select Williams Adley & Company as ACERA's External Audit Firm chosen from the Request for Proposal for the years 2016 – 2020. The motion carried with 5 yes (Cain-Darnes, Carson, Gamble, Walker, Wood), 3 no (Basgal, Koppenhaver, Rogers), 0 abstentions.

Audit Committee's Recommendation to Approve the External Auditor's recommendation of the methodology to implement GASB 74 & 75.

#### 16-131

It was moved by Tarrell Gamble and seconded by Liz Koppenhaver to approve the External Auditor's recommendation of the methodology to implement GASB 74 & 75. The motion carried with 8 yes (Basgal, Cain-Darnes, Carson, Gamble, Koppenhaver, Roger, Walker, Wood), 0 no, 0 abstentions.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Discussion of and Possible Motion to adopt the Proposed Timeline, Search Criteria, and Evaluation Matrix for ACERA's General Investment Consultant Search.

ACERA Chief Investment Officer Betty Tse reminded the Board that the Proposed Timeline, Search Criteria, and Evaluation Matrix for ACERA's General Investment Consultant Search was presented as an Information Item at the September 14, 2016, Investment Committee meeting. Today, Staff is seeking the Board's consideration and approval regarding adoption of the RFP meeting materials at today's Board meeting. Since that time, Staff has continued to review the pertinence of the Timeline, Search Criteria and the Evaluation Matrix. Staff updated and changed the date in the Proposed Timeline to October 21, 2016 (Attachment I, Step 5). Ms. Tse also reported that, in view of the current state of ACERA's entire Portfolio, a risk element was rather essential, and, therefore, Staff clarified the language contained in the Proposed Evaluation Matrix by changing the description contained in the previous version from "Active management" to "Risk management" (General Investment Philosophy, Item Number 2a, Attachment III). Ms. Tse assured the Board that the information contained in the Attachments was consistent with all of ACERA's RFP search requirements and announced that Staff plans to present the finalist candidates for interview at the May 2017 Investment Committee meeting.

Ms. Tse also highlighted the only notable changes in the Proposed Search Criteria, regarding (1) insurance requirements that the Firms must have applied for the insurance by contract execution time; which will allow the flexibility to include additional qualified candidates (Item g, Attachment II, and (2) the language in the Proposed Search Criteria section (Item j, Attachment II) was changed from *Separate Discretionary versus Non-Discretionary Practices, if applicable*, **to** *Distinguish between Discretionary versus Non-Discretionary Practices, if applicable*.

Tarrell Gamble moved and George Wood seconded a motion to adopt the Proposed Timeline, Search Criteria and Evaluation Matrix for ACERA's General Investment Consultant Search. However, before the motion was completed, ACRE President Pete Albert requested that the applicants include a diversity report along with their other responses to ACERA's RFP. As a result of Mr. Albert's request, Trustee Gamble withdrew his motion.

Discussion followed regarding the definition of, content of, and placement of any such diversity report. The original motion was amended to have Staff come back with a recommendation on the particulars of diversity reporting and how it could be included in the RFP. Based on Staff's recommendation, Trustee Basgal said that the Trustees could then make a decision as to how to proceed.

#### <u>16-132</u>

It was moved by Tarrell Gamble and seconded by Keith Carson to adopt the Proposed Timeline, Search Criteria and Evaluation Matrix for ACERA's General Investment Consultant Search and for Staff to include a diversity report regarding ownership and senior leadership of the applicant in the RFP. Staff is also expected to recommend the language of the diversity report in the RFP. The motion carried with 8 yes (Basgal, Cain-Darnes, Carson, Gamble, Koppenhaver, Roger, Walker, Wood), 0 no, 0 abstentions.

#### **PUBLIC INPUT**

Mr. Albert announced that the ACRE Holiday Luncheon will take place at Hs Lordship's Restaurant on December 2, 2016, and the invitation coordination of ACERA Trustees/Staffs' attendance at the Luncheon will be forwarded to ACERA Executive Secretary Angela Bradford.

Ms. Tse announced that as a result of ACERA's Passive Index Search, ACERA has received input and inquiries regarding ACERA's Minimum Requirements.

### **BOARD INPUT**

Chair Basgal reported that SEIU (Rosenberg Foundation) just released a Report regarding the issue of Diversity and requested that the information be provided to the Board for consideration.
