Staff recommends that the Retirees Committee recommends to the Board of Retirement a motion to accept the December 31, 2013 Supplemental Retiree Benefit Reserve (SRBR) Actuarial Valuation prepared by The Segal Company.

2. Adoption of Medicare Part B Reimbursement Plan Benefit for 2015

Recommendation and possible motion to continue to provide Medicare Part B Reimbursement Plan benefits (MBRP) to current eligible retirees at the lowest standard monthly premium rate.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Retirees Committee recommends to the Board of Retirement to continue to provide the Medicare Part B Reimbursement Plan benefit (MBRP) to eligible retirees in 2015, and approve the reimbursement based on the lowest standard monthly Medicare Part B premium at the rate of \$104.90. The MBRP benefit is a non-vested benefit funded by contributions from ACERA Employers to the 401(h) account. After contributions are made, in accordance with the County Employee Retirement Law (CERL), ACERA treats an equal amount of Supplemental Retiree Benefit Reserve (SRBR) assets as employer contributions for pensions.
