This month's Committee reports were presented in the following order:

#### **Operations:**

Elizabeth Rogers noted that the Operations Committee met on March 7, 2012 at 9 a.m., and reported the following:

JP Singh, Chief Financial Officer, presented the year-to-date operating expenses – budget vs. actual. As of January 31, 2012, actual expenses are \$5,098 over budget.

Vince Brown, Chief Executive Officer and Robert Gaumer, Chief Counsel, presented an overview of Governor Brown's 12-Point Pension Reform Plan which was released on February 2, 2012.

Latrena Walker, Project and Information Services Manager, presented her final update on the Enterprise Document Management System Project (EDMS).

Latrena Walker reported that the Web Member Services Project (WMS) will be implemented in phases beginning on March 26, 2012.

Latrena Walker reported that ACERA launched the Website Redesign Project. A project charter was created and is being used as the governing document to manage the Website Redesign Project which is forecasted to be completed by December 31, 2013.

#### Retirees:

Liz Koppenhaver noted that the Retirees Committee met on March 7, 2012 at 10 a.m., and reported the following:

Kathy Foster and Robert Gaumer reported in response to questions at the February Board meeting about eligibility for the Retired Member Lump Sum Death Benefit, including information contained in the SRBR policy and legal definitions of the word person. To address concerns about reciprocity, Staff will report at the May Committee meeting on the years of service of members for whom this benefit has been paid in 2010 and 2011.

The Committee provided additional direction for the report at the April meeting, including discussion of the historical intent of the SRBR-paid part of the benefit.

The Board had requested a staff reports on cost details of payments made from the SRBR, and for information about costs and benefits of payment of the Implicit Subsidy. Kathy Foster reported on progress in developing this information, samples of charts to be used, and a timeline for presenting the reports at the April Committee meeting.

Sharen Stanek-Lowe provided an update on Wells Fargo check printing services changes to the format of retiree direct deposit statements and the planned elimination of the cover sheet. She also reported on informational mailings by UnitedHealthcare.

Kathy Foster reminded everyone of the annual meeting of the Retirees Associations with health plan providers following this Committee meeting.
